POLITICAL PUBLIC OPINION OF MONTENEGRO August, 2020




Sample

- The sample is representative for all citizens over 18 years
- Total of 1037 of respondents participated in the research survey
- Sample: double stratified with random selection of respondents within defined enumeration areas
- Standard statistical error is +/-3.1 % for the appearances with incidence of 50% with interval of trust of 95%
- Post stratification was performed by gender/sex, age and national affiliation
- Research was conducted in the period from 5 to 12 August, 2020




Montenegro is on the? (%)



Almost half of the citizens think that Montenegro is going on the wrong track, while slightly less than a third of the citizens think that Montenegro is going on the right track.
27,8% of citizens do not know or cannot assess.

Montenegro is on the? trend (%)




A stable trend of decrease of those who think that Montenegro is on the right track



There is a greater number of citizens who are dissatisfied with the Government's performance than those who are satisfied




The performance of PM Duško Marković's Government very and mostly satisfied – trend (%)



In comparison with the end of previous year, satisfaction with the work of the Government has been further reduced


Trust in institutions – SUM

mostly and high degree of the trust (%)




The Educational system,

Trust in the political institutions continues to be decreased



Average rating for politicians on a scale from 1 to 5





Average rating for politicians on a scale from 1 to 5 - trend (%)




Ranking of the ministries

SUM: very and mostly good




Performance of the ministries sum: very or generally good - trend (%)

Each Government member's performance for the period of their mandate 2016-2020 (from 1 up to 5)




Average ratings are generally low on the scale. The Minister of Sports and Youth has been the highest rated, as well as the PM.



- The following data is not a political forecast of the upcoming elections. The data represents the attitude of the citizens at the moment.




Parliamentary elections 2020. Rating of Electoral Lists(%)

Probability for voting the preferred party



Turnout forecast for the upcoming elections with the margin of statistical error



Support for Montenegro's accession to the EU— (%)




Majority of the citizens support Montenegro's accession to the EU

Support for Montenegro's accession to the EU trend (%)




There is a continuous trend of support decrease towards the accession

Support for Montenegro's membership in NATO – (%)




A majority of citizens have a negative attitude towards Montenegro's membership in NATO

Support for Montenegro's membership in NATO - trend (%)




On whom should Montenegro rely in its foreign policy – (%)




Every fourth citizen thinks that Montenegro's foreign policy should rely on the EU, whereas every fifth citizen thinks that it should be Russia

On whom should Montenegro rely in its foreign policy (%)




Attitude on Government's offer towards the Serbian Ortodox Church


